

## **Access-It Library: Enabling Enhance TV AccessIt V9**

*Guide for build 3030+*

*Enhance TV* product and features are available for Australian Customers only.

### **What is Enhance TV?**

Enhance TV is an organisation that records Australian TV, store and enhances the content. This service is exclusively for Australian K-12 Schools that has the appropriate copy-write licenses

See below an excerpt from the EnhanceTV website.

*Who is eligible to sign-up to EnhanceTV?*

*EnhanceTV is available for all teachers and students associated with an eligible Australian school. An eligible Australian school is one which has a Screenrights licence. This excludes tertiary institutions. All Government and Catholic schools, as well as many independent schools, have a Screenrights licence. 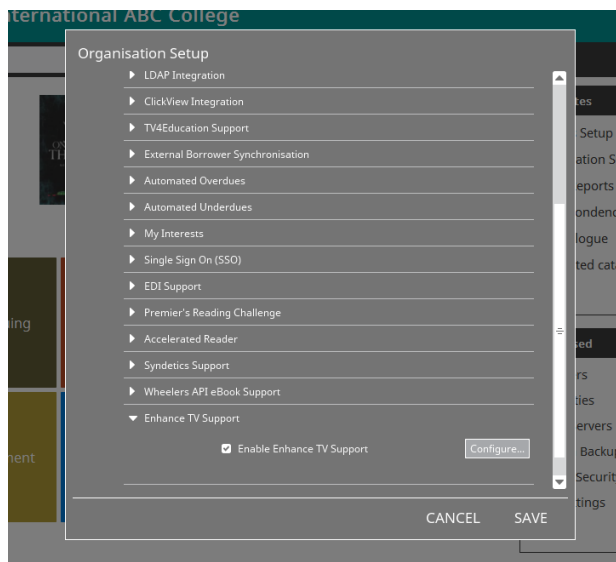
## How to set up:

### Step 1 – Enable Enhance TV in Accessit

#### Step 1.1

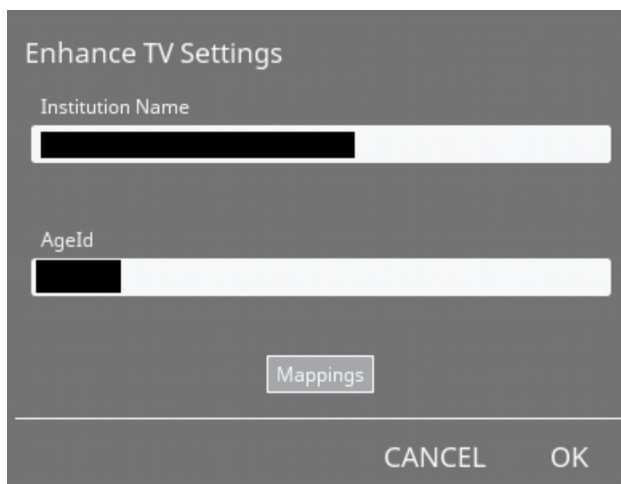
To enable Enhance TV, you need to go to [Library Setup] [Organisation Setup] This will list a variety of different items, scroll towards the bottom to find ‘Enhance TV Support’

Enable using the tick-box, and click [Configure]



#### Step 1.2

Enter you Enhance TV settings. Your Institution Name and AgeID are supplied to you by Enhance TV themselves



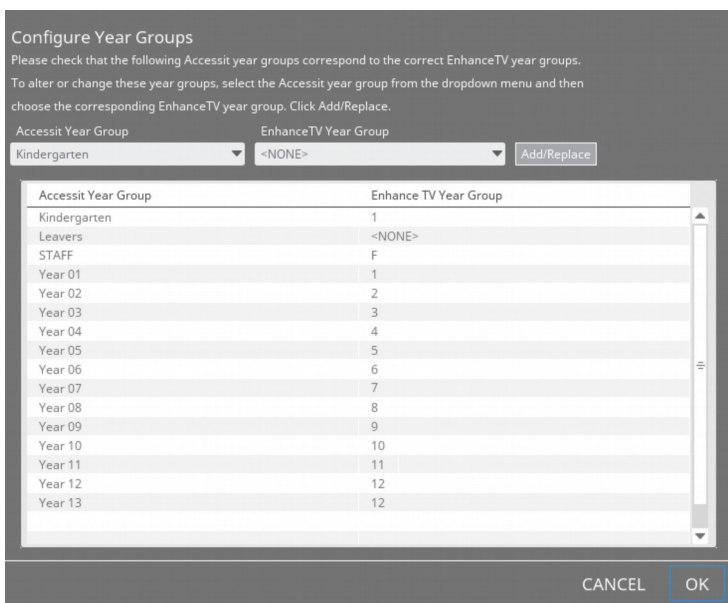
### Step 1.3

Select [Mappings]

This is where you can specify what AccessIt Year groups to match against the Year levels specified in Enhance TV.

In most examples, it should just be a direct 1:1 listing, however, some schools may group their students in AccessIt into sub schools (e.g. Junior School). This is where you can map the appropriate AccessIt groups, to the year levels in ETV.

Save your settings, and return to the Home Menu.



### Step 1.4

To check that Enhance TV has been added to the list of OneSearch providers. You can find this in [Library Setup] [Campus Setup]. Double click the campus, and then scroll down, to find 'One Search' and expand that section. You should have 'EnhanceTV (Restricted)'.




*\*The restricted means the borrowers MUST be signed into the web-app for the OneSearch provider to be visible.*

## Step 1.5

Once setup, you will need to make sure that your borrower records contain an appropriate ‘Year Group’ and the borrower must also have a unique e-mail address.

Go into [Borrowers]  
[Borrowers]

Have a look at a student record. Please ensure that the highlighted fields have the correct values assigned to them for those students. If they do not have an e-mail or year group, then Enhance TV will NOT work for that student.



Staff members should not have any ‘Year Group’ assigned to them, this will NEED to be empty.

These settings allow ETV to uniquely identify the student that has sign in, and gives them the appropriate rights to see ETV video’s.

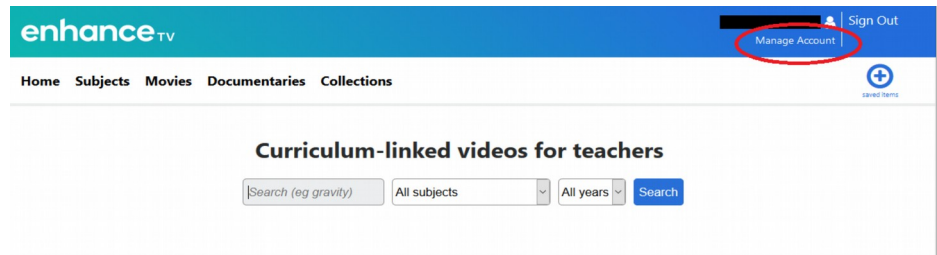
## Step 2 – Configure Enhance TV

Once setup in AccessIt, you'll want to check which video content is set for each year level in Enhance TV.

You will need to sign into the Enhance TV website with an administrative account.

### Step 2.1

Select 'Manage Account' at the top right corner under you login details



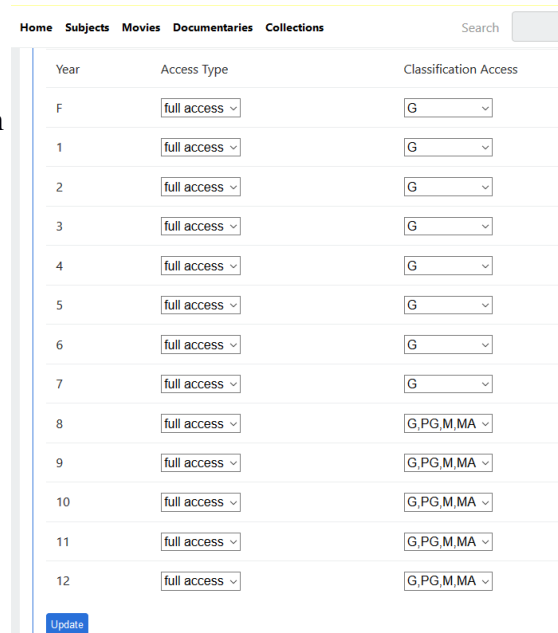
### Step 2.2

Once you are managing your account, you should then have a option to select 'Student Restrictions'. If you don't have this option, then you'll need to sign in with the administrative account. (Contact Enhance TV to gain access to this)



### Step 2.3

Once 'Student Restrictions' has been selected, you can then select what video content is permitted for each year level. This is selected by 'Classification Access' for each Year Level.



## Step 3 – Testing Enhance TV

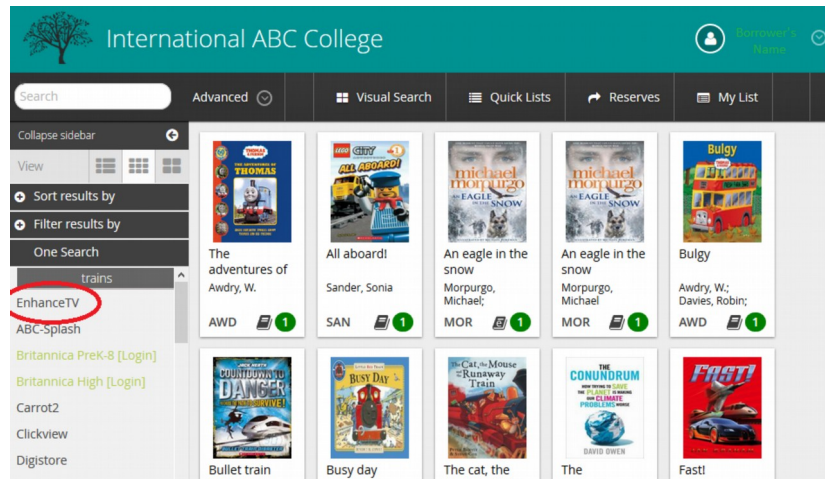
### Step 3.1

Open a browser, and navigate to your AccessIt Web-app. You will need to be signed in as a borrower, that has been setup.

Once the borrower has logged into the Web-App, they can perform a search.

Here in this example, I've performed a search for 'trains'.

Under the 'One Search' tab on the left, EnhanceTV is listed.



### Step 3.2

By clicking on EnhanceTV, this will then open in another tab and take you to the EnhanceTV site, and perform the search for trains on behalf of the student that is signed in.

It should open a tab that looks like this, listing the search that was performed on the left, and listing the results.
